

PERMIT TO LICENSE STEPS

1. Complete the online driver's education course or the classroom education course and receive the Certificate of Education.
2. Take the written test at the DMV and get your permit.
You will need the following:
 1. An appointment at the DMV. (www.DMV.CA.gov)
You can walk-in with no appointment but must take the test by 4:30 p.m.
 2. Certificate of Education
 3. Birth certificate or passport (originals only)
 4. DL44 - DMV application (both parents must sign)
 5. \$31.00 - DMV application fee

GET YOUR PERMIT

3. Enroll for behind-the-wheel training. Your permit is not valid until a driving school instructor signs the second page of your permit. Plan ahead and sign up before you go to the DMV so you can schedule your lesson shortly after your permit test.
4. Complete the minimum six hours of driving lessons with SDS (you will get a Certificate of Completion) and fifty hours (ten at night) with your parents or someone over 25 years old with a CA license.
5. Pass the DMV road test.
You will need the following:
 1. Permit - must hold for six months
 2. Certificate of Driver's Education
 3. Certificate of Completion of Driver's Training
 4. Vehicle Registration
 5. Proof of Insurance for the car you are driving.
